All members of SAPSU and all Pro-Am skaters are required to adhere to the Code of Conduct.

- Act and deal with other skaters, coaches and officials in a professional manner, treating everyone fairly and with respect.
- Maintain discipline in a fair but firm manner.
- Motivate the skater to perform to the best of his/ her capability.
- Continually communicate with the skater in a clear, understandable manner.
- Have a sound moral character, as he/ she has to act as a role model for the skater.
- Sympathize with the skater's needs, and have concern for them.
- Be enthusiastic about the task.
- Maintain a clean and neat personal approach.
- Attempt to make sessions interesting and fun when possible.
- Not openly degrade or criticize the skaters, coaches or officials.
- Be able to listen to the skater and include their views in the training process.
- Provide regular and timeous feedback to skaters regarding the skaters training progress.
- Be available to share his/ her expertise and experience with the skater.
- Ensure that training is completed in a healthy and safe environment.
