

**A****SKATING DIVISIONS AND APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS****1 Divisions of figure skating**

Figure skating consists of:

- 1.1 Single Skating (Men/Boys and Ladies/Girls)
- 1.2 Pair Skating
- 1.3 Ice Dance
- 1.4 Synchronised Skating

**2 Application of ISU regulations**

Any reference in these regulations to any jump, spin, pair skating, synchronised skating or ice dancing requirement, whether for the purposes of championships, competitions or tests shall:

- 2.1 where such jump, spin or pair skating requirement is defined or otherwise specified in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Singles & Pair Skating, have the meaning assigned thereto in such Regulations **unless otherwise decided and communicated by the NTC**;
- 2.2 where such ice dancing requirement is defined or otherwise specified in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Ice Dance, have the meaning assigned thereto in such Regulations **unless otherwise decided and communicated by the NTC**, and
- 2.3 where such synchronised skating requirement is defined or otherwise specified in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronised Skating, have the meaning assigned thereto in such Regulations **unless otherwise decided and communicated by the NTC**.

**3 Authority to Delay the implementation of amended ISU Special and Technical regulations**

When necessary, the NTC, after consultation with the Council, may delay the implementation of any amendments by the ISU to the ISU Special and Technical regulations applicable in any SAFSA or Provincial Event, including Tests, until such time that such amendments can be implemented in SAFSA and/or Provincial Events, including Tests.
