

P**ACCOUNTANTS AND SYSTEMS****1 Appointments**

All Accountants who must be eligible members (or eligible members with restricted rights except remunerated coaches) of SAFSA shall be appointed annually (Appendix No. 9) by and at the discretion of the Council for the current year only on the recommendation of the National Accountant. A list of such appointments shall be sent to each [Province](#). Any new additional appointments recommended by the National Accountant thereafter may be authorised by the Executive to hold office until the following years appointments are submitted to the Council.

1.1 Class

The following shall be appointed:

- 1.1.1 A National Accountant and a National Computer Accountant shall be selected from the panel of Chief Accountants.
- 1.1.2 Chief Accountants who shall have passed the appropriate examinations, have marked at least one Senior National Championship and must be able to operate the computerised marking system.
- 1.1.3 Accountants who shall have passed the appropriate examinations and have marked at least three Provincial Championship.
- 1.1.4 Probationary Accountants who still have to pass the examinations.
- 1.1.5 Computer Accountants who are qualified to operate the computerised marking system referred to in Section P, part 1.5 of these regulations.

1.2 Provincial Appointments

Accountants shall be appointed to the Province in which they are a registered member but they can mark Championships and Competitions at any National, Provincial or other event subject to the provisions of Section P, part 1.3 of these regulations.

1.3 Number and level of Qualifications to mark Events

The minimum number and qualification level is as follows:

- 1.3.1 For National Championships or Competitions:
2 Accountants.
- 1.3.2 For Provincial Championships or Competitions:
1 Accountant and 1 Probationary Accountant.
- 1.3.3 For Club Competitions:
1 Accountant and 1 probationary Accountant.

1.4 Examinations

The examination to be written by all Accountants shall be set by the National Accountant and marked by him or by any Chief Accountant nominated by him.

The pass marks for the examination are an overall mark of 85% but not less than an 80% mark for each question.

1.5 Computerised Marking System

- 1.5.1 In addition to the ISU manual system referred to in Section K(ii) ([Result Calculation and Publication, 6.0-based Judging System](#)) of these regulations, the ISU Computerised Marking System must be the dominant system in use and may be supported by the manual system at any Championship or Competition and for the preparation of Judges Placing Schedules and Protocols.
- 1.5.2 Persons to be appointed as Computer Accountants must be fully conversant with the program system (software) and qualified to operate it.

1.6 Accountants Travelling Expenses

- 1.6.1 National Championships
Accountants appointed by the Executive and officiating at the National Championships will have their travel expenses and accommodation paid by the Association on a basis determined by the Executive
- 1.6.2 Interprovincial / Provincial Championships
The Provinces will be responsible for payment of travelling expenses of the Accountants who they appoint to officiate at Provincial events.
